Interpretation of data for SPAN 1010: The Gen Ed Test for Span 1010 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). A downward trend of 6% in the PASS % is perceived throughout cycle. However, the PASS % has been very high and satisfactory throughout the cycle, with a lowest value of 87%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for SPAN 1020: The Gen Ed Test for Span 1020 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). A downward trend of 4% in the PASS % is perceived throughout cycle. However, the PASS % has been very high and satisfactory throughout the cycle, with a lowest value of 82%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for FREN 1010: The Gen Ed Test for French 1010 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). A downward trend of 7% in the PASS % is perceived throughout cycle. However, the PASS % has been high and satisfactory throughout the cycle, with a lowest value of 75%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for FREN 1020: The Gen Ed Test for French 1020 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). A downward trend of 2% in the PASS % is perceived throughout cycle. However, the PASS % has been high and satisfactory throughout the cycle, with a lowest value of 80%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for CHIN 1010: The Gen Ed Test for CHIN 1010 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). For four semesters of the cycle evaluated the PASS % has been very high and satisfactory, with a lowest value of 85%. However, from fall 2011 to spring 2012, the PASS % decreased by 87%, reaching a lowest value of 13%, 57% below the norm of 70%. The results for the last semester of the cycle are certainly negative.

Interpretation of data for CHIN 1020: The Gen Ed Test for CHIN 1020 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). A downward trend of 12% in the PASS % is perceived throughout cycle. However, the PASS % has been high and satisfactory throughout the cycle, with a lowest value of 88%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for AR 1010. The Gen Ed Test for AR 1010 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). For the three semester of the cycle evaluated, an upward trend of 10% in the PASS % can be perceived. The PASS % has been very high and satisfactory with a lowest value of 90%, against the norm of 70% in PASS %.

Interpretation of data for AR 1020. The Gen Ed Test for AR 1020 includes two categories: PASS (P) and FAIL (F). For the three semesters of the cycle evaluated the PASS % has been at 100%, the highest value. The results are very satisfactory.
