Our Mission

The Art & Design program prepares a diverse student population to succeed in visual arts, art education, and design. Our courses are an inherent part of a university liberal arts education, teaching students to be highly proficient in art & design skills, critical thinking, synthesis, creativity, respect, and ethics. Faculty and students are engaged in exhibitions, programs, and public projects connecting the university to the community — showcasing art and design as integral parts of culture.

Highlights

Art & Design has spacious and well-equipped design, photography, printmaking, drawing/painting, fiber arts/weaving, ceramics, and sculpture/metalsmithing studios. Students can major in graphic design, 2D studio art, 3D studio art, or art education PK-12. It has two galleries. Both professional artists' work and student work are shown in the President's Gallery; students can exhibit their work and curate exhibitions in the University Gallery. In addition, students lead art activities in Student Affairs, collaborate on mural projects, and have opportunities to participate in internships. Faculty all have terminal degrees in their fields and teach all courses; there are no graduate students teaching courses at CSU.
