




Chicago State University

Chicago State University (CSU) is a comprehensive, nationally accredited university with four colleges offering over 70 degree and certificate programs, ample scholarship opportunities and a vibrant campus life.

Rise Academy

The *Rise* Academy is a gap-closing scholarship program uniquely designed for eligible first-year and transfer students who enter into Chicago State University with less than 24 credits. Covering only full-tuition and fees, Rise Academy provides a wide-range of services that foster student success through academic and personal support.

Rise Scholars Earn



*The scholarship does not cover Room and Board.

The program starts with a 5-week course, (Specifically Two 5 Week Courses in the Summer and One 5 Week Course in the Fall), and continues with holistic student support throughout the academic year. The goal of Rise Academy is to help Rise Scholars build the confidence and skills needed for a successful college career. Rise Scholars:

- » Test drive their CSU courses
- » Learn how to make the most of their CSU resources
- » Explore and find their career path
- » Establish lasting relationships across the CSU campus

FUTURE IN MOTION

Distinguishing Features

- » Rise Scholars have access to all CSU resources.
- » Rise Academy has served more than 450 first-time freshmen.
- » Compared to first-time freshmen who don't participate in Rise, Rise students are more likely to complete the full first year of college.
- » More than a third of first-time freshmen at CSU are also the first in their family to go to college.
- » We find that first-generation college students who participate in Rise versus those who do not are more successful in college in their early years:
- » Rise students have a higher college GPA by the end of their first year
- » Rise students are more likely to re-enroll for a second year of college
- » Many Rise Scholars participate in other scholarships after completing the program (eg. Call Me MISTER, Hope Chicago, Honors College, ROTC, STRADA, AIM High Scholarship)

Rise Eligibility

All incoming full-time freshmen students, including transfer students with no more than 24 credit hours who are admitted to CSU with a 2.5 GPA and complete the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) are eligible.

All students admitted to the university through our conditional admit program, SuccessU, are required to participate in Rise Academy and complete all program requirements throughout their first year.

All students must sign a contract to accept the scholarship, agreeing to participate in all required workshops and activities and successfully complete the first 5-weeks of the RISE Academy program in order to be eligible to receive the tuition scholarship.

Out of state students and those desiring to live on campus are strongly encouraged to contact our Housing and Residence Life team to ensure they complete all housing requirements in advance, to secure a place in the residence halls at the conclusion of the 5-week cohort. Space is limited.
