HONORING OUR LEGENDS OF SOCIAL WORK

Each year the Social Work Department awards two scholarships to current students in the Master of Social Work (MSW) Program - the Gladys Scott Community Service Award Scholarship and the Dr. Mikal Rasheed Scholarship.

Established by Dr. Doris Perry, Director of Chicago State University's MSW Program from 1998 to 2006, in memory of her mother, the Gladys Scott Community Service Award Scholarship continues the legacy of Gladys Scott, a dedicated community and political activist from Chicago's Hyde Park area.

The Dr. Mikal Rasheed Scholarship honors Dr. Mikal Rasheed, the first African-American male to receive a PhD from Loyola University Chicago School of Social Work & beloved Director at Chicago State University's MSW Program from 2006 to 2016.

As we take time to remember our legends of Social Work, we encourage everyone to see the importance of community, spirituality, and advocacy in Social Work. It is in these efforts that our students will continue this legacy.
